*Deut. 6:5* And you shall love Jehovah your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.

*Deut. 10:12* And now, O Israel, what does Jehovah your God ask of you except that you fear Jehovah your God so that you would walk in all His ways and love Him and serve Jehovah your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

*Deut. 30:6* And Jehovah your God will circumcise your heart and heart of your seed, so that you will love Jehovah your God with all your heart and with all your soul, that you may live.

*1 Sam. 16:7b* For it is not how man sees that matters; for man looks on the outward appearance, but Jehovah looks on the heart.

*Psa. 45:1* My heart overflows with a good matter; I speak what I have composed concerning the King. My tongue is the pen of a ready writer.

*Psa. 73:1* Surely God is good to Israel, To those who are pure in heart.

*Psa. 73:25-26* Whom do I have in heaven but You? And besides You there is nothing I desire on earth. My flesh and my heart fail, But God is the rock of my heart and my portion forever.

*Prov. 3:3* Do not let lovingkindness and truth forsake you: Bind them around your neck; Write them upon the tablet of your heart.

*Prov. 3:5* Trust in Jehovah with all your heart, And do not rely on your own understanding.

*Jer. 20:9* But if I say, I will not mention Him Or speak any more of His name, Then it is in my heart like a burning fire, Shut up in my bones, And I am weary of holding it in, Nor can I.

*Jer. 24:7* And I will give them a heart to know Me, that I am Jehovah; and they will be My people, and I will be their God; for they will return to Me with their whole heart.

*Jer. 32:39* And I will give them one heart and one way, to fear Me all the days, for their own good and form the good of their children after them.

*Ezek. 36:26* I will also give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you; and I will take away the heart of stone out of your flesh, and I will give you a heart of flesh.

*Matt. 5:8* Blessed are the pure in heart for they shall see God.

*Matt. 6:21* For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

*Matt. 11:29* Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me for I am meek and lowly in heart, and you shall find rest for your souls.

*Matt. 15:8* This people honors me with their lips, but their heart stays far away from Me.

*Matt. 15:18* But the things which proceed out of the mouth come out of the heart, and those defile the man.

*Matt. 18:35* So also will My heavenly Father do to you if each of you does not forgive his brother from your hearts.

*Mark 11:23* Truly I say to you that whoever says to this mountain, Be taken up and cast into the sea, and does not doubt in his heart, but believes what he says happens, he will have it.

*Mark 12:30* But you shall love the Lord your God from your whole heart and from your whole soul and from your whole mind and from your whole strength.

*Luke 2:19* But Mary kept all these things and pondered them in her heart.

*Luke 6:45* The good man out of the good treasure of his heart, brings forth that which is good, and the evil man, out of the evil treasure of his heart, brings forth that which is evil, for out of the abundance of his heart his mouth speaks.

*Luke 8:15* But that which is in the good earth, these are those who in a noble and good heart hear the word and hold it fast and bear fruit with endurance.

*Luke 18:1* And He told them a parable to the end that they ought always to pray and not to lose heart.

*Luke 21:34* But take heed to yourselves lest perhaps your hearts be weighed down with debauchery and drunkenness and the anxieties of life, and that day come upon you suddenly as a snare.

*Luke 24:25* And He said to them, O foolish and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken.

*Luke 24:32* And they said to one another, Was not our heart burning within us while He was speaking to us on the road, while He was opening to us the Scriptures.

*John 14:1* Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also into Me.

*John 14:27* Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

*John 16:22* Therefore you also now have sorrow; but I will see you again and your heart will rejoice, and no one takes your joy away from you.

*Acts 2:46* And day by day, continuing steadfastly with one accord in the temple and breaking bread from house to house, they partook of their food with exultation and simplicity of heart.

*Acts 4:32a* And the heart and the soul of the multitude of those that had believed was one.

*Acts 11:23* Who, when he arrived and saw the grace of God, rejoiced and encouraged them all to remain with the Lord with purpose of heart.

*Acts 13:22b* I have found David, the son of Jesse, a man according to My heart, who will do all My will.

*Acts 14:17* And yet He did not leave you without witness, in that He did good by giving you rain from heaven and fruitful seasons, filling your hearts with food and gladness.

*Acts 16:14* And a certain woman named Lydia...was listening, whose heart the Lord opened to give heed to things spoken by Paul.

*Rom. 1:21* Because though they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God or thank Him, but rather became vain in their reasonings, and their heart, lacking understanding, was darkened.

*Rom. 2:15* (Who show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience bearing witness with it and their reasonings, one with the other, accusing or even excusing them.)

*Rom. 2:29* But he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is of the heart, in spirit, not in letter, whose praise is not from men, but from God.

*Rom. 5:5* And hope does not put us to shame, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.

*Rom. 6:17* But thanks be to God that though you were slaves of sin, you have obeyed from the heart the form of teaching into which you were delivered.

*Rom. 8:27* But He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints according to God.

*Rom. 10:1* Brothers, the good pleasure of my heart and my petition to God for them is for their salvation.

*Rom. 10:8-10* But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart," that is the word of the faith which we proclaim, That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; For with the heart there is believing unto righteousness, and with the mouth there is confession unto salvation.

*1 Cor. 2:9* But as it is written, "Things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard and which have not come up in man's heart; things which God has prepared for those who love Him."

*1 Cor. 4:5* So then do not judge anything before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and make manifest the counsels of the hearts, and then there will be praise to each from God.

*2 Cor. 1:22* He who has also sealed us and given the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge.

*2 Cor. 3:2* You are our letter, inscribed in our hearts, known and read by all men.

*2 Cor. 3:3* Since you are being manifested that you are a letter of Christ ministered by us, inscribed not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tablets of stone but in tablets of hearts of flesh.

*2 Cor. 3:15-16* Indeed unto this day, whenever Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart; but whenever their heart turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away.

*2 Cor. 4:1* Therefore having this ministry as we have been shown mercy, we do not lose heart.

*2 Cor. 4:6* Because the God who said out of darkness light shall shine, is the One who shined in our hearts to

illuminate the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

*2 Cor. 4:16* Therefore we do not lose heart, but though our outer man is decaying, yet our inner man is being renewed day by day.

*2 Cor. 6:11* Our mouth is open to you, Corinthians, our heart is enlarged.

*2 Cor. 7:3b* You are in our hearts for our dying together and our living together.

*2 Cor. 9:7* Each one as he has purposed in his heart, not out of sorrow or out of necessity, for the Lord loves a cheerful giver.

*Gal. 4:6* And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, Abba, Father!

*Gal. 6:9* Let us not lose heart in doing what is good, for in the proper season we will reap if we do not faint.

*Eph. 1:18* The eyes of your heart having been enlightened, that you may know what is the hope of His calling, and what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints.

*Eph. 3:17* That Christ may make His home in your hearts through faith, that you, being rooted and grounded in love.

*Eph. 5:19* Speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and psalming with your heart to the Lord.

*Phil 1:7* Even as it is right for me to think this concerning you all because you have me in your heart, since both in the defense and confirmation of the gospel you are all fellows partakers with me of grace.

*Phil 4:7* And the peace of God, which surpasses every man's understanding, will guard your hearts and your thoughts in Christ Jesus.

*Col. 2:2* That their hearts may be comforted being knit together in love and unto all the riches of the full assurance of understanding, unto the full knowledge of the mystery of God, Christ.

*Col. 3:15* Let the peace of Christ arbitrate in your hearts, to which also you were called in one Body; and be thankful.

*Col. 3:16* Let the word of Christ, dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to God.

*1 Thes. 3:13* So that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all His saints.

*2 Thes. 2:16-17* Now our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who has loved us and given us eternal comfort and good hope in grace, Comfort your hearts and establish you in every good work and word.

*2 Thes. 3:5* And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the endurance of Christ.

*2 Thes. 3:13* But you brothers, do not lose heart in doing good.

*1 Tim. 1:5* But the end of the charge is love out of a pure heart and out of a good conscience and out of unfeigned faith.

*2 Tim. 2:22* But flee youthful lusts, and pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

*Heb. 3:12* Beware, brothers, lest perhaps there be in any one of you an evil heart of unbelief in falling away from the living God.

*Heb. 4:12* For the word of God is living and operative and sharper than any two edged sword, and piercing even to

the dividing of soul and spirit and of the joints and marrow, and able to discern the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

*Heb 8:10* For this is the covenant which I will covenant with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will impart My laws into their mind, and on their hearts I will inscribe them; and I will be God to them, and they will be a people to Me.

*Heb. 10:22* Let us come forward to the Holy of Holies with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.

*1 Pet. 1:22* Since you have purified your souls by your obedience to the truth unto unfeigned brotherly love, love one another from a pure heart fervently.

*1 Pet. 3:4* But the hidden man of the heart in the incorruptible adornment of a meek and quiet spirit, which is very costly in the sight of God.

*1 Pet. 3:15* But sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, being always ready for a defense to everyone who asks of you an account concerning the hope which is in you.

*2 Pet. 1:19* And we have the prophetic word made more firm, to which you do well to give heed as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.

*1 John 3:19-21* And in this we know that we are of the truth, and we will persuade our heart before Him, Because if our heart blames us, it because God is greater than our heart and knows all things. Beloved, if our heart does not blame us, we have boldness toward God.

*Rev 2:23b* I am He who searches the inward parts and the hearts.
